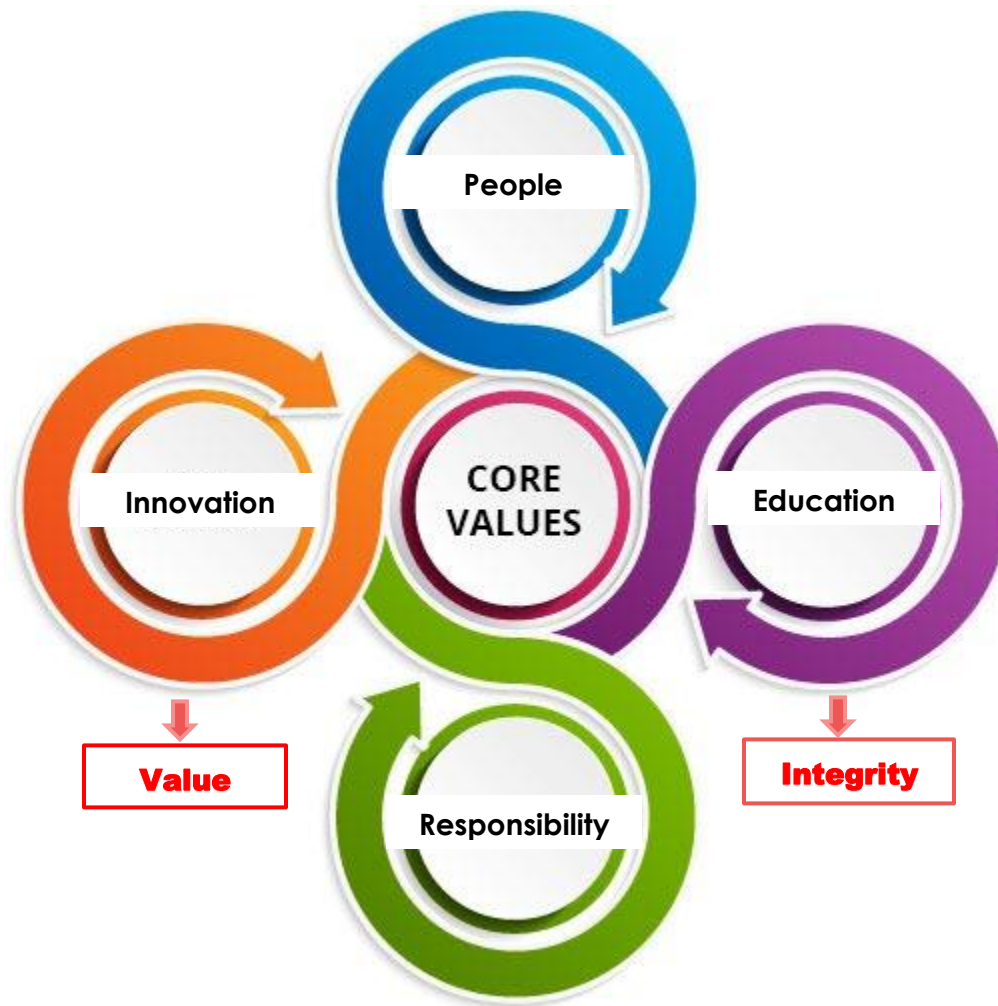

ADMISSION REQUIREMENT



UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMMES

For a candidate to be considered for admission into DFICU Associate or Bachelor's Program, he/she must possess 5 O/level credit passes at not more than 2 sittings. The credit passes must be relevant to the proposed course of study, and may be obtained from WAEC, NECO, NABTEB, GCE, BAC+ or equivalent professional qualifications. Matured candidates with considerable education may however be considered after passing an entrance examination. Candidates with OND, NCE, A/L GCE, University Diploma, Associate Degree and equivalent professional qualifications are acceptable for direct entry admission into 200 Level of the relevant degree programs while HND/Higher Diploma holders will spend two to three semesters for the degree conversion programs depending on the type of course offered.



POSTGRADUATE PROGRAMMES



Postgraduate Diploma:

Applicants must hold a Bachelor’s Degree, HND or equivalent Professional Certificates.

MASTER’S DEGREE PROGRAMMES

Master’s of Business Administration:

Applicants must possess a good Bachelor’s Degree with a minimum of Second Class Honors (Lower Division) from DFICU member universities or other recognized Universities. However, Final professional Certificates of Chartered Professional Bodies such as ACIA, ACA, ACCA, ACIMA, ACIS, ACIB, CIPM, IDPM (London) ACPA, CTeach -(CCT), DELFC2 -(ALTE), as well as HND with Upper Credit, or other recognized Institutions are also acceptable for the MBA Program. In all cases, more than one year post qualification cognate experience is required.

Master’s of Science:

Applicants must possess a good relevant Bachelor’s Degree with a minimum of Second Class Honors (Lower Division) from recognized Universities or For the Faculty of Management Sciences, Final Professional Certificates of Chartered Professional Institutes such as ACIA, ACA, ACCA, ACIMA, ACIS, ACIB, CIPM,



IDPM (London), ACPA, etc. Applicants who demonstrate brilliant academic performances during Postgraduate Diploma programs or holders of MBA Degree may also be considered for admission into the M.Sc Programs.

Master’s of Philosophy:

Applicants must normally possess a Master’s Degree in addition to a good Bachelor’s Degree in a relevant discipline from a recognized University. However, applicants with good Bachelor’s Degrees with Second Class Honors (Upper Division) or First Class Honors may be admitted directly into the M. Phil. Programs. Holders of professional Master’s degree (M. Sc.) are also eligible to apply for the M. Phil. program.

DOCTORAL DEGREE PROGRAMMES



Doctoral Degrees (By Course Work and Thesis):



Applicants must possess a good Master's Degree with average score of 60% or better (or equivalent of 4.00 on a 5.00 GPA scale) in addition to a good Bachelor's Degree in a relevant discipline from any recognized Universities.

Doctoral Degrees (By Publication):

Candidates for the Degree of PhD / DSc. / D.Ed. by Publications must be members or past members of staff/ alumni of a recognized University or research Institution. In order to be eligible for consideration, alumni must be graduates of at least five years' standing and have already obtained a Master's Degree. However, in exceptional circumstances, other candidates may also be considered. Applications may be made at any time and such applications should be accompanied by:

- (i) A list of the publications to be submitted; these may include refereed articles, authored chapters, authored books, and edited works. They may not include course readers, internally published materials or unpublished seminar/conference papers,
- (ii) A supporting paper; this should summarize each publication submitted, outline their interrelationships, give a critical review of the current state of knowledge and research in the applicant's field and indicate how his or her work has contributed to the field. It should also comment on the standing of any journals and the reception of the publications as indicated by citations and reviews.

Criteria for the award of the degree: To be awarded a Degree of PhD / D.Sc. / D.Ed. / D.Eng. by Publication run by DFU, HEGT or BAU or any DFICU member Universities, a candidate must show that his or her work makes a significant contribution to knowledge in a particular field. The publications must also provide



evidence of the capacity of the candidate to pursue further research, representing a coherent contribution to research in a given field and demonstrating a depth of scholarship and originality comparable with that required in a PhD thesis. The materials submitted shall be sufficiently extensive as to provide convincing evidence that the research constitutes a substantial contribution to knowledge or scholarship, and at registration, the candidate shall submit for examination:

- (a) Three copies, in published form, of each items forming part of the work on which the applications for the Degree by Publication is based. Permission to include work in manuscript, but which has been accepted for publications, may be granted upon a request by the applicant,
- (b) Four copies of the supporting papers referred to above, modified, if necessary after consultation with the adviser. A full bibliography of all the work ever published by the candidate must be included as an appendix,
- (c) A statement as to what part (if any) of the materials have been submitted for a Degree or other qualifications at DFICU member universities or any other university or institution, explaining the reason for its inclusion and, if joint work is submitted, what part of it is the candidate's contribution. In all cases, possession of a good Bachelor's Degree from a recognized University is mandatory.

Doctoral Degrees (By Research): This option is available to advanced academic staff in the Universities or other research institutions. The basic entry requirements are as follows:

- (i) A good Bachelor Degree with a minimum of Second Class Honors (Upper Division),



- (ii) A Master Degree in relevant disciplines with average score of 60% or better (or equivalent of 4.00 on a 5.00 GPA scale)
- (iii) Must be working in a University or a research institution as a lecturer, instructor or researcher
- (iv) A minimum of 5 years working experience is mandatory,
- (v) A minimum of 5 academic and/or professional publications in relevant disciplines in the mixture of journal articles, textbooks, contributions to books, edited books, monographs, etc. is mandatory.
- (vi) Possession of Final Professional Certificate of recognized Chartered Professional Institute will be an added advantage.

Having met the above conditions, the applicant ONLY needs to write the Thesis/Dissertation on an Approved Topic relevant to his area of specialization to fulfill the requirements for the award of the Doctoral Degree. Applicants holding Master's Degrees with average score less than 60% (or GPA of 4.00 out of a 5.00 scale) who wish to enroll for the PhD may be considered for M. Phil./PhD alternative. However, irrespective of the submission by the Applicants, the decision of DFICU member universities is final on admission, which is also dependent on availability of space. NOTE: If a candidate of PhD by Research wishes to specialize in any area of study, he/she should write his thesis in that area.



CERTIFICATION



Upon completion of ones programme, exams and approved dissertation / thesis, the certificate is awarded by our Member University or Dove Française University depending on the choice institution at the beginning of the programme. This can be collected by hand or send via DHL to the registered / designated address nationwide. This certificate is also accompanied by the course completed transcript and or apostilled documents. Please note, only degrees awarded by Dove Française University shall be accompanied by apostilled certificate.

RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The Student Right:

Student Responsibilities

Faculty Responsibilities

The University faculty members will take all reasonable steps to ensure that:

Students have access to necessary materials and resources

Students know how and when they may contact the faculty member

Students are aware of all relevant academic services available to them (particularly the e-library services)

New students receive appropriate information on procedures, services, and personnel relevant to their introduction to the University and their continued studies.



Termination of the Student Enrollment Agreement

The Student Enrollment Agreement will end automatically, subject to the student's rights of internal appeal, if the student's status in the University is terminated as a result of:

1. Action taken against the student in accordance with the University's disciplinary procedures
2. A decision of the faculty, based on the student's academic performance
3. Non-payment of fees, in accordance with the University's regulations on payment of fees.

The date by which the notification is postmarked, phoned or emailed is the effective date of the withdrawal. Any tuition or fees owed to the student will be refunded within 30 days of the receipt of the notice of withdrawal provided the candidate has not commenced lectures.

All fees owed to the University are due immediately upon termination of the Student Enrollment Agreement. Accounts that have a negative balance will be sent to a 3rd party collection service.

Student Complaints and Grievances

Dove Française University provides a written procedure which details how students or other parties may register a complaint or grievance, how the institution will investigate the complaint, and how the institution will attempt to resolve the complaint.

The University is committed to handling any student complaint in a way which:

1. Encourages Informal Resolution

6. The Behavior of another Student

If a student wishes to make a complaint, he or she must do so within 60 days of the date on which the event occurred. A complaint may only be made by a student or a group of students only, and will be treated with caution.
